Expectations

- Teach a minimum of 1 class (weekend & evenings) per month from April-October 2024
- Participate in a pre-season "Level 1" class and assessment before being invited to attend instructor training. Multiple locations, dates TBD
- Attend an Evergreen New Instructor Training. Dates below, ~9am-5pm each day:
 - Issaquah: March 16-17
 - Ellensburg: April 6-7
 - Port Gamble: April 20-21
 - Spokane: May 4-5
 - Wenatchee: May 18-19
- First Aid / CPR Certified
- Undergo a background check if interested in working with youth
- Prompt, courteous, and professional representation of Evergreen
- Attend team meetings & events (average of 4 throughout the season)
- Commit to improving your skills as a rider and educator
- Please note that acting as a positive mentor and creating a safe and fun learning environment is our number one goal. Advanced riding skills are NOT required to excel in this role.
