Responsibilities:

- o Lead and manage the relationship with DNR, the riding community and local stakeholders.
- Recruit, lead, train and manage Evergreen project staff of trail builders and crew leaders.
- Recruit, train and manage lead volunteers (designers and builders).
- Create, own, execute and manage the project plan.
- Approve all design and construction elements.
- Track and control project budget and invoices.
- o Ensure all components of the project are delivered on time, in scope and within budget.
- Ensure compliance with DNR cooperative agreement.
- o Provide regular status updates and engage the Trails Director on key issues, risks and roadblocks.
- Coordinate with Evergreen staff (Executive Director, Operations Manager, Communications Manager, Volunteer Coordinator, Bookkeeper).

Required Qualifications:

- o College degree.
- Project management experience.
- o Familiar with trail design, construction and maintenance concepts and techniques.
- Ability to collaborate with staff, volunteers and partner agencies to plan, organize, manage and deliver projects on time and within budget.
- Experience leading volunteers.
- Experience leading sub-contractors.
- o Highly organized with attention to detail.
- Excellent written and verbal presentation skills.
- Excellent interpersonal communications skills.
- o Proficiency with MS-Word, Powerpoint, Excel, mapping and project management software.
- Tolerance for discomfort. Work happens even in cold and wet weather and the ability to maintain team spirit in those conditions is important.
- Valid driver's license, clean driving record and reliable personal vehicle.
- Represent Evergreen & the sport of mountain biking in a positive, professional manner at all times.
- Understanding of popular mountain biking styles, trail designs and trail features.

Desired Qualifications:

- At least 2 years direct project management experience working with work breakdown structures, budgeting, earned value, critical path analysis, GANNT charts and project management software.
- Strong trail building skills and keen understanding of IMBA Trails Solutions and USFS Standards.

- Proven ability to lead by influence vs. authority.
- Experience with GIS.
- Excavator operation experience or experience leading heavy equipment operators.
