Evergreen Mission:

Evergreen is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that creates and protects sustainable mountain biking opportunities in Washington.

Summary of Position:

The Trail Builder I primary function is to work with Evergreen staff and volunteers to maintain and build trails at Evergreen project sites. Key new trail construction projects include (but are not limited to) North Mountain, Raging River and Tiger Mtn. This position requires a hard worker with some trail building experience, a strong desire to learn trail building skills, and a passion for mountain biking. Work will occur on weekdays and weekends.

Reports To: Mike Westra. Coordinates primarily with Project Site Crew Chief or Project Manager.

Responsibilities:

- Work with Evergreen Builders, Crew Leaders and Project Managers on a variety of trail construction and maintenance activities.
- Supervise volunteers as needed.
- Ensure work is performed according to objectives and standards.
- Communicate work progress and issues to Crew Leader or Project Manager.
- Ensure hand tools are stocked, organized and in good working order.
- Help manage equipment, tools, refreshments, sign-in sheets, waivers & work party logistics.
- Represent Evergreen and the sport of mt. biking in a positive, professional manner at all times.

Qualifications:

- A strong desire to learn trail building skills and a positive attitude.
- Desire and ability to work hard and with minimal oversight.
- A high level of strength is not necessary, but endurance and fitness are critical.
- Tolerance for discomfort. Work happens even in cold and wet weather and the ability to maintain team spirit in those conditions is important.
- Proficiency with Google Email and Excel. GPS/GIS Mapping software experience a plus.
- Valid driver's license, clean driving record and reliable personal vehicle.
- Excavator and chainsaw operation experience and skills a plus.
